7:25 PM – [Update/Discussion] Class of 2024 Testing Issues (5 minutes)

- Class of 2024 Senate -
 - On our recent summative NBME exam, we had several questions that were out of scope for the material provided in our coursepacks/lectures
 - The exam had really low test averages
 - Curriculum reps and class president met with the course directors after the exam and they said
 it was a "systems curricular issue" instead of an individual course director/lecturer issue. For the
 first time, Dr. Bosch isn't the sole pathbio course director, rather several people are in charge
 due to the systems nature.
 - Curriculum rep We talked about these issues in the CMC meeting this month as well and the same answer was given
 - Dr. Booza recently sent out a resolution, adding 15% to each students grade for this exam,
 which people seemed pretty content with
 - Also, this is a PSA to other class senates to advocate for regular meetings with Dr.
 R/Booza/Course Directors after exams because this a good example of how issues are solved
 - We also recently had a lot of frustration expressed in the M1 GroupMe after last interactive review session
 - After students struggled to get the right answer to a question, the instructor's answer was "Google it" and students were really upset about that
 - Lecturers were really bad at explaining the reason the correct answers are correct and their answers are very vague in the review sessions such as "google it" or "we gave you the tools in lecture", this isn't the purpose of the review sessions

- As a senate, we want to encourage you to reach out to your curriculum reps so that they can help you with these issues as well. They used to do formative feedback sessions at the end of each block so that students could come give course feedback, are they not doing those anymore? Course directors seemed to take those pretty seriously when they had them
 - Have been in contact with Dr. Booza about these focus groups, but he has not been super responsive so they have not been happening but we do want to get them going again
- Dr. Rajasekaran and Dr. Booza are coming to the next senate meeting and we will invite curriculum reps as well so that they can weigh in
 - 2025 Curriculum reps will be elected soon September 3rd is the Meet and Greet, elections will follow soon! Would like the reps here at the next meeting. Plan to have elections open for a week.
 - Can 2023 have an additional rep election at the same time as one of our reps had to step down?
 - Yes, we can run a special election in time for the next meeting!
