6:25 PM – [Discussion] Listserv access (10 minutes)

- Senators recently had a meeting with Dr. Chadwell, Dr. Rajasekaran, Susan Hanchet, Aime Dozier, and Dr. Brennan about Listserv use and why it is so important for students to retain access to the listservs in some capacity.
- A letter was drafted and sent to them with this information, including how loss of access would impact both the SOM and surrounding communities. This is going to go to Dean Schweitzer as well and the meeting attendees were very supportive
- Potential Solutions Proposed:
 - Propose greater use of GetInvolved, but probably not because it has its own host of issues
 - Student Org Emails that have sending privileges
 - Professional Email Use Training
 - This could be done through BSO, and would enhance professional development
 - Professionalism Addendum to clarify potential consequences and outlining procedures to address email misuse
 - Suggestion from the senate to use the BSO comms chair to police the emails.
 - Might be too much for one person
 - Maybe there can be a reporting system for too many emails, could go on the BSO feedback form
 - To clarify, this professionalism citation threat is definitely not mainly meant for overuse of the email system - it is more so meant for the things like microaggressions, problematic subject matter, etc.
- GetInvolved Information, what is it used for?
 - Collecting updated information for the org and ensuring that they are registered with main campus to have official org status. This also allows them access to main campus funds
 - The comms chair through BSO looked into it and said that it is not a good way to advertise events or for regular communication. It is really designed for undergraduate campuses
 - Service Learning Website - GetInvolved can be linked so that at least there is an up to date org list
 - We were being registered incorrectly as “main campus” orgs
 - SOM has its own tab, we will address this in the next round of org transitions
 - It is definitely designed for a college campus, and we are finding that it just may not work out well for us, definitely something to emphasize at the meeting
