- Post-CMC membership meeting and additional details involved in this presentation
- SJMEC was established in 2020 in response to a community needs and assets assessment performed by the IJI, with the purpose of removing and revising racism in medicine, social justice, diversity and equity
- A new entity was deemed necessary for this curriculum overhaul project
- Previously met 1-2 times per month as a coalition and more often as needed with regular meetings with Dr Rajasekaran, but now have monthly meetings with Dean Roy
- Essentially want a more formalized structure for these revisions
 - o Clinical skills, P4 review, basic sciences/UME curriculum review
 - Microaggression training
 - Development of social justice core competencies
 - Additional iterative workshop/training for basic science faculty on creating content in an anti-racist light
 - Formal reporting system for curriculum related JEDI issues
 - Establishment as permanent subcommittee of CMC
 - Long term goals
 - Build out social science curriculum across all four years
 - Positive social justice faculty development
 - Increase D&I of visual images around the school
 - Leadership roles
 - Lead facilitator x2, secretary x1, SJW coordinator/strategic planner x3, CMC representative x2, student body liaison x2, research coordinator x2,
