# 6:45 PM – [Update] Back to Campus Task Force (10 minutes)

- We ran through how academic classes would be affected with the recent change in COVID restrictions, seems like no big effect within SOM
- Regarding day to day operations
  - Scott Hall Gym closed indefinitely Mort Harris open though after a brief period of closure
  - Student Org Protocols
    - No food at any event
    - Service Learning is approved to still be in person, no more than 50 persons if outside, no more than 30 if inside
    - If your org is planning an event just for fun, has to be virtual
- Will revisit in Jan after break
- Student? How were the new rules enacted? What was the trigger metric if we are all vaccinated here at the SOM for the most part?
  - There remains a small cohort of unvaccinated and on campus individuals. This is the population they are regularly testing to survey positivity rates and setting new thresholds
- This doesn't make much sense? Why are we still tying this to the unvaccinated population when they are such a small percentage of those on campus at the SOM?
  - There are about 800 people across the campuses who are unvaccinated
  - Dr. Rajasekaran asked for numbers of unvaccinated from just the SOM and it sounds like there aren't enough people at the SOM unvaccinated to even get enough statistics to make an informed decision
  - Unfortunately, even though the SOM has a very high vaccination rate, they can't really
    make an exception for the SOM and not let other health professional schools in the
    same boat that are close to main campus (Nursing, Pharm), so it seems like a "we are all
    in this together" sort of policy
- GET YOUR FLU SHOT!! Starting in January, your screener won't work if you don't have your paperwork in. Of note, in the submission form, it says to be sure the picture of the

- documentation you submit must contain your birthday, but the campus flu shot clinic ones did not have that information and it will still go through.
- GET YOUR BOOSTER!! To maintain compliance with University policy, documented booster shots must also be submitted using the same form as the flu shot one by the start of winter semester.
- Probably time for new student reps for this committee as we transition to dedicated
  - Victoria Badia can do it!
  - Encourage M1s to get involved! These kinds of committees are great intros to the business of admin communications
    - Arya Gaddam (M1 pres) will join as well
