## 7:05 PM – [Discussion] Constitution Changes (20 min)

- Zoom
  - Not saying that zoom should be completely removed, but there should be some sort of formal limiting to keep people mainly in person
    - Conversations in person are significantly more robust and thorough
  - Some in favor for limiting but not overlimiting zoom, the issue mainly comes with quantifying
  - Solution to opt-in to zoom, where you email in and state your justified reason why
    - Unlimited reasons to these
  - You should be attending in person unless you literally cannot
  - Oftentimes people on zoom will not be actively paying attention
    - Number of votes should always match the number of people on zoom, so when it doesn't work like that they should definitely abstain
  - o Maintain the abstain button, maintain cameras on?
  - More barriers when students are on zoom
  - Need to take into account students that cannot make it due to school, especially M3s and M4s
  - Still need to be aware of covid policies
  - M4's voicing concerns for wanting to still be involved and needing zoom to do that while they have special demands during M4 year and feel like they aren't being supported or appreciate for that.
  - Should be a little more proactive about absences, make sure to email the secretary before you have to be absent
  - External senate committee members are ok to have their cameras off
