- Elections are all done, waiting for response from class reps about acceptance of position
- Will be meeting next week to discuss external committee elections
- OSR is doing their election at the next senate meeting on 8/30/22

6:15 PM – [Presentation] SJMEC added to Faculty Curriculum Management Committee (CMC) (10 min)

- CMC is composed of faculty leaders and mostly faculty and course director membership, and subcommittees that run each component of the curriculum
 - o A subcommittee for clinical, preclinical, etc
- Mostly faculty based but there are 2 student reps from each class year
- SJMEC formed, in 2020, in response to a community needs and assets assessment done by IJI that revealed that there are important components of racism in medicine and social justice related content that is omitted, outdated, or in need of correction.
 - Currently proposing to have the charge to ensure that the medical school curriculum includes and properly addresses important issues concerning racism in medicine
- Did a complete review of HDF1, including 94 lecetures
 - Found 60+ instance of outdated information that could use additional context, or removal of offensive terms, etc
 - Was distributed to Dr. Walker who reported it to the course directors that then revised the information
- How to make it a sustainable entity that continues to do this work? Currently acting solely on their own as students
- A lot of different entities that work similarly and ask for these changes continually but they get lost in complication or in the system, such as BMA, IJI, etc
 - SJMEC will be one of the membership entities under a newly consolidated SDAC (Student Diversity Avisory Council) that the lead facilitator of IJI (Emily Otiso) is working on
- Formed a proposal to act as a specific committee of the CMC that does this on a regular basis
- Should student senate govern elections/membership for the SJMEC in some way? Like external committees?
- Feedback
 - Make SJMEC a part of the curriculum committee and mix their responsibilities
 - How will incorporation of the student senate into this committee affect the process that this committee engages in?

- Better to leave it as more of an administrative with student input than student-based committee
- For each round of curriculum review, there are students (Social Justice Warriors), that are wiling to assist with this work and as they watch lectures, keep an eye out for any sort of social justice issues that arise in the way the curriculum is taught
- There is a faculty leader identified and willing to lead the committee, Dr Rodrigo Andrade
- Motion to table this discussion until the next senate meeting when we can have curriculum committee members present, seconded, passed

6:25 PM – [Discussion] Faults in School of Medicine Website (15 min)

- The official school website is completely lacking, including lack of information, broken links, etc
- Students often send emails to faculty asking for information instead of navigating the website because they constantly get lost or can't find the information
- Dean Sakr agrees that we need to fix this
 - Put together a "task force team" yesterday
 - Want it to include the technology committee
 - Learned a bit more that there was someone somewhat responsible for this who designed the website, hired a company, and there were complications and a lot of content was lost and the website was pretty much given up on since 2017
 - Trying to identify the people responsible for making website changes
 - Have a google folder with all the information that gets put on the website
 - Want to triage the most important things that help students
 - Create a priority list for repairs for the website
 - Write up a sustainable plan of action

- Alumni event "Making the Rounds"
 - Two sessions that students can sign up for, 4-pm and 6:30-8:30pm
 - 200 people per session, event will be completely free and include appetizers and two drink tickets
 - o All students will have to register, first come first serve
 - Hopefully get at least 40-50 faculty/residents that would participate
 - o 400 is the max
 - O How will the event be run?
 - Table top meet and greet situation?
 - Only students who have paid their dues should be allowed to attend, will be good incentive for them to get their dues in
 - o SUITS/Dressy?
 - Maybe have short 10 minute speakers every now and then?
 - Have some sort of organized set first to make sure that it's not awkward or something?
 - Having pre-set talking points for residents

 - Ask instead about how to budget

 - "What to Expect as a Resident" for the name; reach out to residents preemptively with discussion topics
 - Also want to talk about job market and job offers that the senior residents are getting (EM, RadOnc, etc job markets)
 - Maybe we can split up the times between M1/2 and M3/4 students so we can tailor discussions, or at least split up the "assigned teams" if we're doing that

- Can we ask Diane to prioritize current residents or alumni from classes of 2017-2022 first for the signup because I feel like we, esp as M1/2, rarely get the chance to interact with them and ask about more pertinent things like COVID/leave policies, virtual interviews, job market, step studying, budgeting, etc. The people who run the alumni zoom specialty sessions are always well established or basically about to retire and can't give us good answers about applications/finances/research because they're so far removed. Also allow the alumni to decide whether they want to attend one or both sessions and sign up separately.
